As part of STEF's partnership with the NQT association, two STEF recruiting officers welcomed 12 graduates from priority neighbourhoods or disadvantaged background for a personalized coaching workshop.

These graduates (with at least a BA degree) received practical advice from human resources professionals on what the logistics industry and its major operators could offer. They benefited from useful information to build their professional project and an analysis of their personal and professional experience.

NQT is now a major player in developing skills of young graduates from priority neighbourhoods or socially disadvantaged backgrounds. A local experimentation developed in Seine-Saint-Denis gave birth to the association of the same name in 2006. It now covers the whole of Ile-de-France and Rhône-Alpes, Midi-Pyrénées, Aquitaine, PACA, Nord-Pas-de-Calais, Poitou-Charentes, Mayenne and overseas counties (Guadeloupe and Reunion). NQT offers a unique support system based on mentoring, with the support of partner companies. Since 2006, more than 19,660 graduates have been accompanied, 72% of them recruited on a job that meets their qualifications. 5,100 mentors are currently mobilized and 760 partners are part of this initiative.
